

Welcome to the last INNOGROW newsletter!


As the project has come to a successful end, it is time to review the success stories in the final newsletter of the project.

INNOGROW, as an Erasmus+ Project implemented with the support of Turkish National Agency, brought together all important actors in innovation and entrepreneurship in Europe, to design an innovative eLearning methodology directed towards potential entrepreneurs and intrapreneurs. The partnership worked hard to develop high quality contents in all of the outputs and the final output [INNOGROW App](#) reached far beyond its predefined features. Today we have over 400 users (entrepreneurs / intrapreneurs) from Turkey, UK, Spain, Greece and Romania using the App for the purposes of self-assessment, eLearning and Business Model Development.

Major activities implemented since the third newsletter of the project are the Innovative Entrepreneurship Camp in Thessaloniki, Greece and Innovative Entrepreneurship Summit in Gaziantep, Turkey.

The five-day seminar entitled “Innovative Entrepreneurship Camp” (Classroom Training and Business Development Workshop) was successfully organized from 19th to 23rd of June 2017 in Thessaloniki.

The seminar was successfully organized thanks to 16 learners that participated, coming from Greece, Spain, Romania, United Kingdom and Turkey and to the highly experienced speakers from KiNNO Consultants Ltd. (Greece), KIM Knowledge Innovation Market S.L. (Spain), The National Council of Small and Medium Sized Private Enterprises in Romania (Romania), MAKRO Management Development and Consulting Ltd (Turkey), Gaziantep Teknopark (Turkey) fulfilling the purpose of its implementation.

In this 5-day event, the first 3 days were devoted for trainings on the module contents, as 5 modules were taught in an intensive Agenda of 8 hours per day. The remaining 2 days were devoted to participatory discussions on the business models and making amendments on each to be more applicable as could be.

The final event of the project 'Final Conference in Gaziantep' has also been successfully organised with the leadership of Gaziantep Teknopark on 20th September 2017 in Gaziantep. The full day event featured important speakers in entrepreneurship ecosystem in Turkey. That is why it has been entitled as 'Innovative Entrepreneurship Summit'. The conference also hosted two successful INNOGROW pilot programme participants from Greece.

The interest and participation was high by the Gaziantep University Students, who have entrepreneurship potential and who are in the phase of developing their business models, and also the stakeholders active in entrepreneurship ecosystem in the region.
